### *HySecurity Automates Unique Curved Gate*

HySecurity, a manufacturer of premium, heavy duty industrial and high security automated gate systems, was Seattle City Light's choice for their one-of-a-kind curved gate. Seattle's Entrance Control oversaw and installed the inimitable gate at the utility's headquarters, located near Seattle's downtown business district, in November.

Clearance issues and the angle of opening mandated the very odd, radius design.

"Only a pinch roller system like HySecurity's hydraulic SlideDriver could automate this gate," says Richard Woltjer, VP of Marketing and International Business Development. "It's impossible with a traditional chain-driven system."

The cantilever gate is 15' wide by 10' tall and weighs 1,000 lbs., on the low end of SlideDriver's massive gate moving capacity. "There are two gates on this site, the radius entrance gate which cycles up to 150 times per day, and a more typical two dimensional exit gate which cycles up to 250 times per day," says Woltjer.

HySecurity's gate operators secure the perimeter of The Pentagon, Baghdad International Airport, most U.S. Airports, utilities of every type, government facilities, corrections and thousands of critical infrastructure, high security sites worldwide.
